Bankruptcy Study

OVERVIEW



- Goal: Determine if ERS's technology can provide an "early warning" for companies at risk of bankruptcy.
- Period: 12/30/2003 to 4/17/2019
- Method:
 - Identified bankrupt companies with a high market cap of at least \$800 million, delisted 12/30/2003 or later.
 - 223 companies met these criteria.
 - Obtained their stock prices for each of the preceding 7 years before they were delisted.
 - Calculated ERS's Price Risk and Financial Risk indicators for each of the 7 years prior to their delisting.
 - For dates on which ERS could not calculate a company's Price Risk or Financial Risk, those companies were excluded
 - ERS used the larger of the Price Risk or Financial Risk indicators
 - Calculated the percentage decline for each stock in the time periods prior to their delisting.

THIS STUDY PROVIDES COMPELLING EVIDENCE THAT ERS'S RISK MEASUREMENT TECHNOLOGY PROVIDES AN "EARLY WARNING" OF THE RISKS OF BANKRUPTCY



The table on the right shows groups of companies arranged by both their **Risk Ratings** (rows) and the time period prior to delisting (columns).

Column 1 indicates the group's Risk Ratings: the larger of the PRI or the FRI.

Row 1 indicates the length of time prior to the company's delisting.

The higher the risk rating, the stronger the signal ERS would have given to **avoid these stocks** and their resulting losses.

ERS identified 75% of all bankrupt companies in this study as "high risk" (70 to 100) 3 years before delisting.

5 years before delisting, ERS rated 94% of these companies between "weak" and "very weak" (40 to 100).

4 years before their delisting, only $\frac{3}{2}$ companies were rated "safe" (0 to 20).

ZERO delisted companies had an ERS Risk Rating under 10 any time 7 years prior to delisting.
