12/7/2007 – 52 LARGEST UTILITY COMPANIES SEGMENTED BY PRICE RISK RATINGS

On December 7, 2007 (the high date of the Utility sector index), **ERS's Price Risk** ratings of the 52 largest utility companies ranged from 26 to 97.

- Low Price Risk scores, lower risk and greater potential returns are positively correlated
- The five lowest-risk companies produced 29% alpha over the 10 worst-rated companies
